

Jeanne Beacham, president: Jeanne Beacham is President and CEO of Delphon Industries LLC., with Divisions GEL-PAK, and, Quik-Pak, Touchmark and Ultratape, a materials manufacturing company, that is a leading provider of device packaging materials and services, to the Semiconductor and Medical Device Industries. Delphon offers global sales and service support, along with Manufacturing Reps and International Distributors. Delphon has offices in Hayward and San Diego, CA, and Essex Junction, VT.

Jeanne joined Vichem Corporation in 1994 as Vice President of Marketing and Sales of GEL-PAK division, responsible for worldwide sales, marketing, and strategic alliances, along with managing customer service and human resources.

In December, 1997, Beacham led a management buyout of GEL-PAK and in July, 2000, acquired Silicon Packaging Technology in San Diego – creating the acquisition of Quik-Pak as a new division of GEL-PAK. In 2004 Jeanne restructured the company under Delphon Industries to establish a platform to grow the company by both acquisition and organic growth. In 2005 Delphon acquired Touchmark a high precision Pad Printing business serving medical and semiconductor industries.

Delphon was named by the San Francisco Business Times as one of the Top Women Owned businesses in the Bay Area.
